After all the stories I had heard about how the very elements bowed their heads at the sight of Gurudev's divine work at Sidhabari, at the October 1997 Hanuman Ahbisheka at Sidhabari, we again witnessed that miracle continuing. It had been raining hard up until the day of the camp; then the rains stopped, and the camp, along with the filming that had been planned, proceeded in sunshine. Then, on the day of the



abhisheka - when we formed long lines to take our turn at the "bathing" ceremony, and then as we sat down in front of the statue of Hanuman after the oblations were over the sun mercifully hid behind a vast cloud cover, so that the heat would not strain us unduly. Just before the arati, a few drops of rainwater fell to bless the event. And, at the very moment the light was circled in front of Hanumanji, the sun peeped out 20 between the clouds for one long minute and again disappeared from view.

பிரணவமே சூரியன் - சூரியனே பிரணவம்.

சென்ற அத்தியாயத்தில் ஓம்கார தியானத்தை (ஓம்கார உத்கீத தியானம்) பற்றி பார்த்தோம்.

அந்த ஓம் - பிரணவ மந்திரம், ஸ்வரம், உத்கீதம் எனும் பல பெயர்களால் அழைக்கப்படுகிறது.

சூரியன் உதிக்கவில்லை என்றால், பிரம்ம முகூர்த்தமும் இல்லை, விடியலும் இல்லை, மனிதர்களின் செயல்பாடுகளும் இல்லை, ஏன் யக்ஞ - யாகங்களும் கூட இல்லை.

அந்த சூரியனோ உதிக்கும்பொழுது ஓம் எனும் சப்தத்துடன் தான் உதிக்கின்றான். (இன்று அறிவியல் ரீதியாக உண்மை என்று நிரூபிக்கப்பட்டுள்ளது).

யாகங்கள் செய்கின்ற வேதியர்கள் அழைப்பதற்கும் -சம்மதம் தெரிவிப்பதற்கும் "ஓம்கார"த்தையே பயன் படுத்துகிறார்கள். (தைத்ரிய மந்திர கோஷம். ஒம் இதி பிரம்ம, ஓம் இதி தகும் சர்வம்.. எனும் மந்திரங்கள் இதை நிரூபிக்கின்றன)

கௌஷீதகீ என்கின்ற மாமுனிவர் தன் மகனிடம் கூறினார் - நான் சூறிய தேவனையே பாடினேன், நீ ஒருவன் மட்டுமே எனக்கு மகனாக பிறந்தாய், நீ சூரிய தேவனின் கிரணங்களை பாடினால் பல பிள்ளைகள் பிறப்பார்கள்! என்று.

On the whole it was an enthralling experience for all present at the occasion.






Vinayaka Chatturthi Celebration by CHYK - Report

My TREK THROUGH UTTARAKHAND

Started early. The way is rough but pleasant. Came up to the top of the hill. (The detour due to

bridge repair will take another month's free labour - practice goes on - bad - 12 months' old breech). From there, without going down to the Tapta kundas (the Vyasa and the Vasistha), we crossed the village and came straight to the main road. At about 12 noon reached Bhukki near the swinging bridge. Had lunch there and wandered off in search of a shady tree to sleep. Swamiji and Gautam found one. I went in search of another and reached Bhattwari, covering a distance of six miles. This is the dreariest stretch of granite hills. No shade here even for a bird.

Covered these six miles in record time. Expectation is a great spur to man. Expecting shade around each corner, I slogged on the serpentine route and reached Bhattwäri. On the way met a farmer who is on his way to a place 10 miles away from Bhattwäri. Talk - What is Pakistan? Why are the yatris so few? People have lost their faith. The great tragedy has happened. What has become of our Raja? Convinced him-apanā rājā ho gaya. Accha, to yearly tax dena padega? Iswara nama le lo.....


At Bhattwārī met the officer of the State appointed to check if the yātris and the coolies have got their mail or not. We have none. This man is 50 years old, stalwart and heavily built. Has no faith in the Congress. Truth is the dharma of Uttarakhand - is lost now. There is bribery and we have become faithless. The Raja was our faith. The Congress promises food and kapada - where are they? Nonsense. The varnas are going, Hari, Hari! We worship the Brahmanas - even if they never wash their faces. Schools? No please. We do not want them. Rājāsāba had one in Narendranagar and the gharawālās who had education became ambitious and wanted to become Rājās themselves. There can never be more than one Rājā. Now we have ten - it is impossible. It is all the gharavālās work. Jawahara - O, he is God himself. But not his gharavālās. Will they follow Jawahara's advice? Then it is okay. But I am not sure! These are his sentiments. A difficult problem for Congress here. The villagers with their faith and loyalty are not quick to change. Action alone, solid service can bring them around to see reason.

Wanderings In The Himalayas

BADARINATH - 2

True vairagya is the result of thought. The other kinds of vairagya, resulting from various other causes, can, at best, be only weak, temporary and halting.



Yudhisthira's vairagya was of the true type. Stricken with remorse at the death of so many kinsmen and at the thought that he himself had been the cause of such massacre and misery, his mind turned inward. He now pondered over the vanity of worldly things - state, riches and relationships like father and son - over the heartless crimes committed for the sake of such vain things and over the great sorrows man has to suffer in this world and the next, as a result of such thoughtless conduct. His mind thus turned away from wealth and pleasure and learnt to despise kingship and its paraphernalia. His mind rose to the most intense state of vairagya and he resolved to renounce everything and become a sannyasi. In an assembly where his brothers like Bhima, comrades like Kṛṣṇa and teachers like Vyasa were present, he announced his intention to retire to the forest and there, give up his body in penance. Bhima and the other brothers objected. They argued

"If, by sheer renunciation, a king could reach his goal then, even the mountains and trees which have no desires of their own must reach the goal still more easily."

Yudhisthira answered them logically quoting the Vedas, yet, as he could not reject the affectionate advice of Krsna and Vyasa, he had to defer the fulfillment of his wish to a later time. So he continued to rule his kingdom, but in a spirit of perfect detachment. The news of the extermination of the Yadavas as a result of internal strife, and of the passing away of Lord Kṛṣṇa, inflamed the old desire that lay smouldering in his breast. He decided to give up all worldly activities and soon set out on the final journey. His brothers and Draupadi followed him. They moved farther north through the heart of the Himalayas. They had left Badarikashrama behind, when Bhima cried out, 'Alas! Draupadi has dropped down on the way'. Yudhisthira neither stopped nor turned; he just said, 'That is because of her partiality for Arjuna' and passed on. A little later Bhima reported the fall of Sahadeva. 'That is because of his pride in his wisdom', said Yudhisthira quietly and moved on. Thus, one by one, all the brothers fell and Yudhisthira, in intense loneliness, made his way forward, over rock and snow, without once turning back. Just think of his vairagya, his courage and heroism! Let us now follow the route he pursued on the great journey.

Upanishad Gyana Yagna Sep 2023 - Report

Constant reflection on spiritual discourse will naturally • The real self (atman) is distinct from the temporary body. kindle dispassion and discrimination in our mind, and • protect it from petty desires and attractions. Regular . contemplation on the thoughts imbibed in discourse not only protects the mind and intellect from a possible downfall, but also helps them become established in the Supreme Consciousness.

Swamini Vimalananda, senior disciple of Swami Chinmayananda delivered the religious discourse on Keno Upanishad from September 3rd to Sept 7th 2023 from 6.30 pm to 8.00pm the excerpts from the five days of her discourse are given below:

Day 1:

We cannot realize this Divine Soul through our senses. Even DAY 4: the mind cannot reach up to him. It is a concept, which is celestial, and divine that is the reason why it is unreachable by any instrument or means. It is unlike the animate and inanimate and it transcends the speech, mind and intellect. The only thing that can be said is that it inspires the speech, intellect, senses and mind is Brahma.

Day 2:

Kena Upanishad says that the self or atman is the highest power of all. It is amazingly described through a story how the divine self that gave the powers could also take away the forces. There is only one Brahman.

- Material designations do not apply to this eternal soul.
- The atman is spirit (brahman) unchanging, eternal and conscious.
- Consciousness, as spread throughout the body, is a symptom of the soul.

DAY 3:

The Upanishads draw a distinction between man's empirical self and his true Self or Atman. The empirical self is the existential self, subject to sorrow and suffering and subject to change. The true Self is the unchanging Atman that observes the empirical phenomena but is unaffected and undying.

- 1. Emotion + knowledge is first requirement for seeking spiritual path.
- 2. Love for the subject + effort(knowledge) should be present for progress on this path.
- 3. Respect with devotion for enlightenment

The mind has to be prepared, it should look inward.

DAY 5:

It is the nature of mind to wander, we need to engage it in thoughtful, contemplate the spritual words and involve in spiritual work.
